BHA CULTURAL AND LINGUISTIC COMPETENCY TRAINING

The Behavioral Health Administration (BHA), in collaboration with the University of Maryland Training Center, will be hosting a series training sessions on cultural and linguistic competence (CLC) and culturally and linguistically appropriate services (CLAS) standards.

There will be four in-person training sessions offered during September and October 2019. These sessions will include interactive discussions and learning about the importance of data driven approaches, the use of such approaches to address disparities, disproportionality and cultural competence, and the use of the CLAS standards in self-assessment as well as in assessing and addressing the behavioral health needs of all individuals served in the Maryland's Public Behavioral Health System.
