OMS Authorizations

Reminder: Concurrent OMS authorizations can be entered up to 100 days after the expiration date of a previous authorization. If a provider does not complete their concurrent OMS request within the 100 day window an error message will appear stating, *“The previous OMS authorization for this consumer expired more than 100 days ago. Select Continue to proceed with an Initial request or Cancel to correct the OMS interview date.”* The provider must follow the directive in the error message in order to move forward.
