The Department of Health and Mental Hygiene's Mental Hygiene Administration (MHA) and ValueOptions[®] Maryland are pleased to announce that the Outcomes Measurement System (OMS) Datamart is now operational and can be accessed through either <u>http://www.dhmh.maryland.gov/mha/</u> or <u>http://maryland.valueoptions.com/</u>.

The OMS Datamart is designed to track how individuals, ages 6-64, receiving outpatient mental health treatment services in Maryland's Public Mental Health System (PMHS) are doing over time in various life domains, including housing, employment/school, psychiatric symptoms, functioning, substance use, legal system involvement, and general health. The Datamart contains information at the statewide level, as well as at the individual County level. (Please refer to the OMS User Guidelines, which can be accessed through the OMS Datamart Welcome Page, for additional information and background regarding the OMS.)

COMING SOON:

The next phase of the OMS Datamart will be provider-access to provider-level OMS data. It is anticipated that testing of the provider-level access will begin in mid-March. While the OMS Datamart is designed to be user-friendly, training on how to use the OMS Datamart will be provided once the provider-level access is operational.

TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS:

The software that drives the OMS Datamart uses Adobe Shockwave files to display the data. Browsers that will work with the software include Microsoft Internet Explorer Version 6 or higher, Mozilla Firefox Version 2 or higher, and Safari Version 5 or higher. A minimum processor speed of 1.8 GHz with 1 GB of RAM is needed. Adobe Flash Player 9.0.151 (32 bit only) and above are also needed. It may therefore be necessary to update your Adobe software in order to view the Datamart. Unfortunately, iPads do not currently support Shockwave files, so the Datamart cannot currently be viewed on an iPad.
