# **RE:** FEMA-4091-DR-MD - Disaster Declaration for Public Assistance - Applicants' Briefings & Materials

Applicants' Briefings for the Public Assistance Program for Presidential Disaster Declaration (FEMA-4091-DR-MD) as a result of Hurricane Sandy have been scheduled. Please see the attached revised schedule. It is encouraged that all eligible applicants attend a briefing, but attendance is not mandatory.

Briefings have been scheduled for the majority of the counties/jurisdictions that were included in the original declaration. MEMA will continue to schedule briefings as counties are officially included in amendments to the declaration for Public Assistance.

NOTE: Prince Georges, Anne Arundel and Cecil Counties have now been added to the Declaration.

Please be reminded that the **RPA must be submitted** to her attention within 30 days from the declaration (deadline is 12/20/2012) if you wish to apply for reimbursement through the Public Assistance program.
