OUTCOMES MEASUREMENT SYSTEM (OMS) DATAMART REFRESHED WITH DATA THROUGH 12-31-12

As you know, the Mental Hygiene Administration (MHA), ValueOptions, and the University of Maryland Systems Evaluation Center (SEC), collaborated to create the web-based Outcomes Measurement System (OMS) to track outcomes of services delivered at outpatient mental health centers throughout the state. Providers are able to view the State and County level data showing on the public OMS Datamart Web site. The data has also been configured to allow a provider to see their individual provider-level information, using a unique log-in. The provider data has recently been refreshed and now includes OMS data through 12-31-12.

IF YOU HAVE NOT ALREADY ACQUIRED A PROVIDER LEVEL LOG-IN AND PASSWORD, WE HIGHLY ENCOURAGE YOU TO DO SO.

Listed below is the process you need to follow to obtain the log-in and password that will be required to access your provider-level data:

- Each provider will receive one separate ProviderConnect log-in
 - This log-in may be shared by individuals within each provider organization
 - Complete the OMS Provider Registration Form
