

How Do I Recognize the SIGNS of an OPIOID Overdose?

If you notice one or more of the following:

- Breathing: slow, shallow, or stopped
- Blue lips and fingertips
- Gray, clammy skin/vomiting
- Loud snoring or gurgling noises (“death rattle”)
- Person unresponsive
- Slow pulse/No pulse
