SURVEY OF SUD TREATMENT PROGRAMS TO ASSESS CENSUS AND CAPACITY

JANUARY 17, 2017

The Maryland Behavioral Health Administration (BHA), in conjunction with the University of Maryland Systems Evaluation Center (SEC), is conducting a state-wide survey of all SUD Treatment Programs to collect current client census and estimated annual client capacity for each ASAM level of care provided. The purpose of this survey is to better understand the need and capacity for substance-related disorder treatment across the state, to help guide state and local administrators with planning and system development.
