

OVERVIEW OF SURVEY

In January, 2017, the Mental Criminal Justice Partnership's DataLink Subcommittee issued a survey to the 16 jurisdictions that have implemented the DataLink program. A 10-question survey was sent to the Core Service Agencies (CSAs) and Local Detention Centers as well as to the State's Department of Public Safety and Correctional Services (DPSCS) to help us better understand how the DataLink information is being used on a daily basis, to identify best practices, and to determine what can be improved to enhance the coordination of care that exists between the Detention Centers and the local Core Service Agencies.

Highlights of the Responses:

- 15 Detention Centers and 10 CSAs responded to the survey A response rate of 78%.
- 60% of the CSAs and 23% of the Detention Center indicated that they access the DataLink files daily.
- 90% of the CSAs would recommended DataLink to another CSA compared to 67% of the Detention Centers who would recommend DataLink to another facility.
- Overall, **68%** of the respondents felt that DataLink is an effective program.
- Almost everyone surveyed indicated the need for additional training or refresher courses most preferred
 that these be provided online.

Suggestions from the Respondents:

- "Improve the format for an easier search and access." Detention Center
- "Excel importing not very user friendly." Detention Center
- "Listing expired Auth can be challenging to sift through." CSA
- "Need of a better training."- Detention Center
- "Receive unwanted data. Ex- history of someone who has already been released."- CSA
- "Launch datalink application from the link that arrives in the email."- Detention Center
- "Would be helpful if the information was directly entering into the appropriate inmate health record"-Detention Center.
- "Provide a web portal to view the data instead of sending the files in order to improve compliance with HIPPA."- Detention Center

Actions Taken to Improve DataLink:

In order to enhance and improve the access of DataLink files, we have made several changes in the hope of helping CSA and Detention Center staff to improve coordination of care and provide timely treatment to individuals in their care. These changes include:

- An updated Import Template incorporating more descriptive column headings for easier identification of key data elements.
- Added formatting to the Import Template to highlight expired Authorizations in red.
- Added detailed descriptions for each Type of Care in Code Crosswalk document in order to better explain the type of services that an individual may have been receiving in the Public Behavioral Health System.
- Created documents and brief videos detailing the steps necessary to access and download daily Datalink
 files
- CSA and Detention Center staff will soon see an updated e-mail that includes the link to FileConnect (June, 2017).


















